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Architecture studio Archival Studies and clothing brand Artikel København are once again joining forces, now launching a small line of workwear apparel.

The two Copenhagen-based companies have previously collaborated on Artikel's space on Gammel Kongevej, stringing their production and retail program together with a minimum of materials and a clear response to the character and scale of the already existing. This space naturally lays as the backdrop to their exhibition:

Parts of a Whole

Showcasing the Archival x Artikel workwear collection featuring three jackets specifically designed for Archival Studies' studio and workshop in Valby, Copenhagen, reflecting their main materials of production: wood, metal, and natural finishes. The collection includes Joiner Jacket, Machinist Jacket, and Painter Jacket. Developed through a close collaboration between the two companies, the jackets offer the same quality and craftsmanship that the savvy craftspeople imbues their creations with. The collection are available for public commerce through the local Artikel Store.

In addition to the workwear jackets, a manifestation of the companies' fabrication processes working from 2D to 3D is exhibited as a deconstructed timeline in celebration of the locally produced.

The small collection will launch as an open exhibition and event during 3daysofdesign in Copenhagen.

Designed for the painter. The long cut offers more protection and coverage from color stains. The white fabric act as a blank canvas, over time accumulating and displaying the traces of paint.

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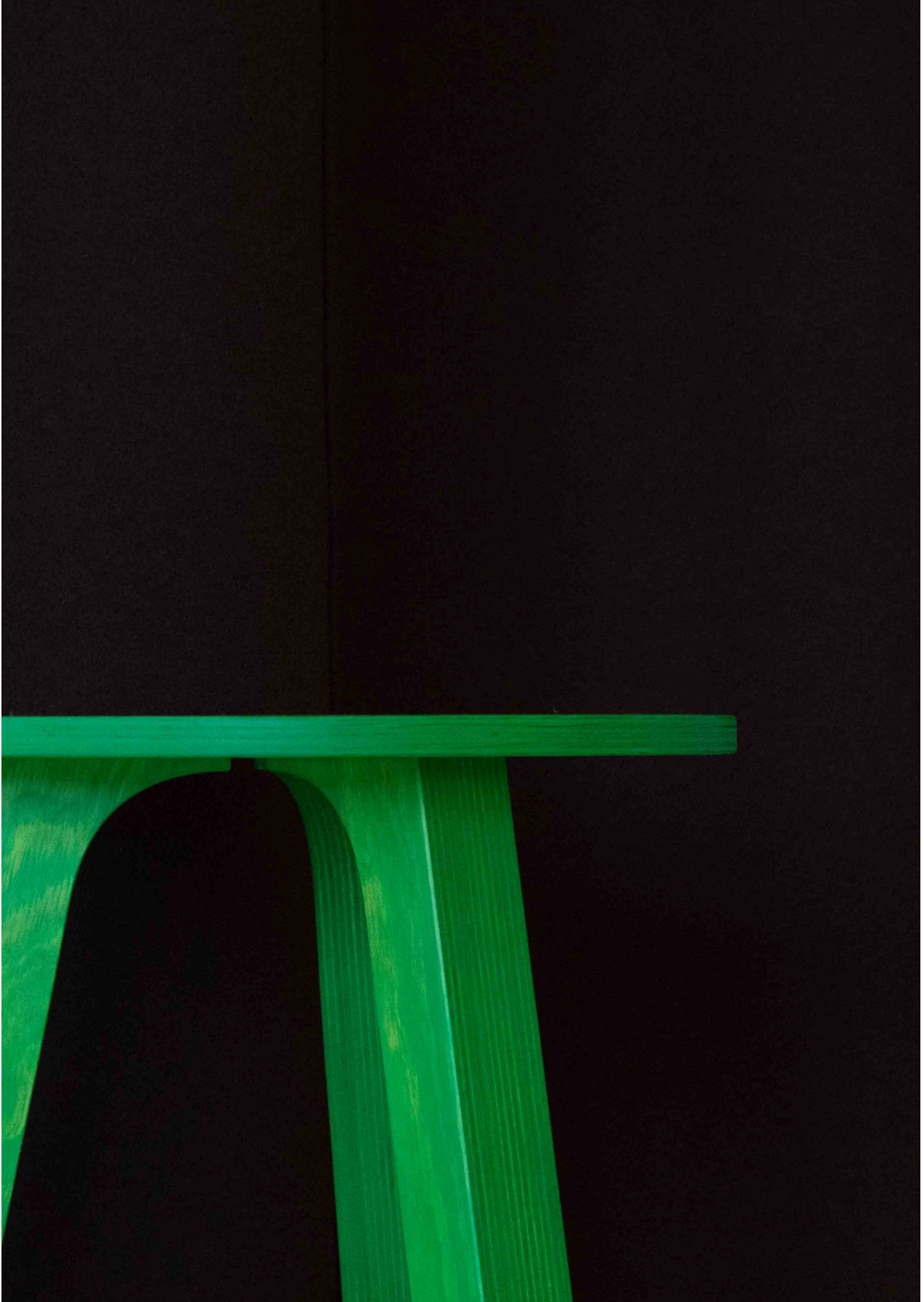
